English does not count!</b>	Research a charity of your choice and find out as much as you can about it. Design a poster to show your findings.	<b>DESIGN A NEW LOGO FOR THE NHS</b>	Create a 3 course meal, design a menu card and list the ingredients that you would need to buy in order to make it.
<b>DESIGN A NEW SPORTS KIT FOR YOUR FAVOURITE SPORTS TEAM OR SCHOOL</b>	Write a letter to a relative who you have not seen for a while. Tell them what you have been doing during the lockdown.	<i>Watch a film of your choice and write a 200 word review of the storyline</i>	Make a planter for the garden.
