We will be holding an information and revision techniques evening for parents and carers of all Year 10 and Year 11 students on **Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> October 2021 from 6pm – 7pm in Trent Hall**. During this evening we will focus on the three Faculty areas of mathematics, English and science. Staff will also be on hand to answer any questions regarding other subjects taught at our academy.
