

Dear Parent / Carer,

I recently wrote to all Parents and Carers of students on the Trent campus regarding a number of key points, one being uniform regulations and infringements. There are a number of students on the Trent campus that are not adhering to the uniform standards, most notably the trousers, so I am writing to reiterate our uniform expectations.

Should your child wish to wear a skirt, it is now the black box pleat style, available from any retailer of your choice. With regards to trousers, they must be plain black - full length (no ankle on show), formal style. Jeans, jeggings, skinny fit and leggings are not allowed. Socks should be plain black or grey. Shoes should be black. Training shoes, boots or canvas shoes are not allowed and there should be no logo on the footwear. Hoodies are not acceptable as part of the academy uniform.

Please be aware that many retailers advertise trousers as 'school wear' when they in fact do not meet our uniform regulations so I would ask that you check our website for a full list of standards and visual examples of acceptable trousers. The web address is www.deferrers.com/uniform.

We understand that it may be difficult to purchase additional uniform items straight away. We are therefore requesting that the uniform standards are rectified for when students return after the half term break – Wednesday 3rd November 2021.

I would also like to remind you students are only permitted to wear a watch, one pair of small plain studs and one plain ring. Nose studs or any other form of body piercing is not allowed. The academy reserves the right to request that students remove jewellery which we believe could cause injury to the students or others.

Students are not allowed to wear visible make-up. Any student wearing make-up that is visible will be asked to remove it. The wearing of a single neutral colour nail varnish is permitted, however false nails are not permitted.

Hair must be of a natural colour. No extreme styles or colours will be acceptable.

Uniform infringements will be sanctioned in line with the Behaviour Policy.
